

TAMIL NADU ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Notification No.TNERC / CBR/1-1 dated : 9.4.2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 181 read with clause (zl) of sub-section (2) of section 181 and sub-section (1) of section 92 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendment to the TNERC Conduct of Business Regulations, 2004, the draft of the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (3) of section 181 of the said Act.

AMENDMENT

In the said Regulations, for sub-regulation (6), the following sub-regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

(6) "All orders of the Commission shall be communicated to the parties in the proceedings under the signature of the Secretary or an officer empowered in this regard by the Commission within seven days from the date of making of the order by the Commission"

STATEMENT SHOWING THE EXISTING PROVISION AND THE PROVISION AFTER AMENDMENT

Existing provision

(1)

All orders of the Commission shall be communicated to the parties in the proceedings under the signature of the Secretary or an officer empowered in this behalf by the Commission.

Proposed amendment

(2)

All orders of the Commission shall be communicated to the parties in the proceedings under the signature of the Secretary or an officer empowered in this regard by the Commission within seven days from the date of making of the order by the Commission”
